 - Please place offerings in the offering plates prior to the beginning of service.
 - Nursery will be provided for children: birth through 3 years of age. Check-in procedures have been established to ensure the health and safety of our children and volunteers.
 - Children 4 and up attend worship with their family.
 - This service **WILL NOT** be available on Facebook Live.
 - Sanctuary will be cleaned at the end of the service.

- **9:45 a.m. Small Groups**
 - Preschool and Children will meet in the Preschool area by the church library. Check-in procedures have been established to ensure the health and safety of our children and volunteers.
 - Youth will meet in the Youth House.
 - Young Adults and Couples will meet in the Fellowship Hall.
 - Mixed Adults Class will meet in Room 117.
 - More classes will be added as needed.

- **11:00 a.m. Worship Service: Masks Optional**
 - Masks **ARE NOT** required to attend this service.
 - The Fellowship Hall will still be open for anyone who wishes to worship from there.
