

Wakefield Central Baptist Church (WCBC)

COVID-19 Policies and Procedures/Waiver

Drop off Procedures-

- All attendees must enter and exit from the same door.
 - If using the Fellowship Hall, use the access door located on the Youth House side of the building.
 - If using the Sanctuary, use the main office entrance door.
- All attendees must follow the Health Screening procedures listed below.

Masks

- Masks are not required in the areas reserved for your activity.

Designated Areas

- All participants must remain in their designated areas at all times, unless using the restrooms.
- While on our campus, participants are not allowed to wander the halls nor enter rooms not reserved for their activities.
- Classrooms throughout the church are cleaned after each use.

WCBC Preschool Area

- WCBC has a weekday preschool and the PS staff cleans their classrooms and the preschool bathrooms each day. **PS classrooms and bathrooms are off-limits for any group using the church facilities.**

Cleaning and Lock-up

- All classrooms and meeting areas should be cleaned/sanitized at the end of use.
- The bathrooms should be inspected to make sure they are be clean before leaving the facility. Please clean/sanitize all door handles and faucet handles.
- Empty all trashcans in the areas used (dumpster is located behind the building)
- Shut off all lights
- Reset thermostat to the "Off"
- Make sure all interior doors are closed and all exterior doors are closed and locked

Hand Washing

- Free standing hand sanitizer stations are located throughout the church.
- Hands should be cleaned each time you enter the building and after using the restrooms.

Health Screening

- Parents and adults are asked to be on ALERT for symptoms of COVID-19. Please do not participate or send your child to participate in a WCBC activity, whether on or off the WCBC campus, if you suspect you/they have COVID-19 or have been exposed to anyone that has COVID or have visible symptoms associated with COVID-19.

These symptoms include, but not limited to:

1. Fever (100.4 or greater) or chills
2. Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
3. Loss of taste or smell
4. Congestion or runny nose
5. Cough
6. Fatigue
7. Muscle or body aches
8. Sore throat
9. Headache
10. Diarrhea
11. Nausea or vomiting

Any individuals exhibiting these symptoms will not be allowed to participate in any activity on our campus until they have met the following:

- 10 days since symptoms first appeared and,
- 24 hours with no fever without the use of fever-reducing medications and,
- Other symptoms of COVID-19 are improving

These policies and procedures will be evaluated weekly and adjustments made as necessary. Any changes or additions will be distributed to families promptly.

I have read and understand the WCBC Covid-19 Policies and Procedures. I agree to abide by these policies, whether participating in a WCBC activity on or off campus or sending my child to participate in WCBC activity on or off campus.
