Saddle up partner and get ready for the wildest week of camp yet! From learning to lasso, to riding ponies, this camp is sure to bring out the cowboy in us all!




June 23-27

## Camp Policies

#### Payment

A \$75 non-refundable deposit per camp will be due at time of sign up. The remaining balance will be due April  $21^{st}$ , unless another arrangement is made with our office. Payments can be made by cash or check.

#### Drop off/Pick Up

Drop off begins at 8:55 am. If you are running late, please let someone know by text. Parents/caretakers will escort child to door for drop-off, and pick up at that same door. Pick up time is 12:00pm. If you are running late- please let us know.

#### Sick Policy

Children should be well enough to comfortably and actively participate in all scheduled activities. Children should not attend camp if they:

- -have a fever of 100,4 or higher
- -have vomited or had diarrhea within the last 24 hours
- -have a chronic cough that impacts their ability to participate
- -have lice or lice nits
- -are diagnosed with any condition that may be contagious to others such as COVID, RSV, hand, foot, & mouth disease, etc. Children may return to camp when they are symptom free without medication for 24 hours or when cleared by a medical professional.

#### Medication Policy

If your child requires a rescue medication such as an inhaler or EpiPen, Benadrylplease let us know. We will keep the medication onsite and administer if needed.
Please keep the medication in its original packaging and label with child's name.
Please apply sunscreen, bug spray, etc. at home before your child arrives at camp.
In the event your child requires additional applications of these types of products,
please notify one of our staff to arrange an appropriate plan.

#### Behavior Policy

In an effort to create a safe environment and positive experience for all, we require that all children behave

in a safe and appropriate manner.

### What to Bring

- -Water Bottle labeled with name
- -Diapers/pull-ups, wipes if needed
- -Complete change of clothes (underwear, socks, shirt, shorts)

#### What to Wear

- -Comfortable, weather appropriate clothing that can get dirty
- -Comfortable shoes. Flip flops and crocs can be worn if child can walk effectively in them and keep them on their feet.
